**Prof. Datuk Dr Mohd Gazali Abas** is presently the Professor of Practice at the Faculty of Economics and Management, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. He retired in July 2020 as Secretary General, Ministry of Education (MOE), after serving the Malaysian government for 37 years, since 1983. He had also served as Secretary General of Human Resources Ministry, Director of National Institute of Public Administration (INTAN), Executive Director for Network of Asia Pacific Schools of Public Administration and Governance (NAPSIPAG), Head of INTAN Leadership Centre, Head of INTAN Economic Centre, Assistant Director of Budget Division, Ministry of Finance, and in Planning Division, Ministry of National and Rural Development. He had represented the government on numerous boards and councils. He is now a member of Competition Appeal Tribunal under the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs since November 2020. A PhD holder in Global Information and Telecommunication Studies (Economics) from Waseda University, Japan (2005), MBA (Finance) from Nottingham University, United Kingdom (1991), Advanced Diploma in Public Administration from INTAN (1986) and Bachelor of Economics (Hons.), the University of Malaya, (1983).



**Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Sulaiman Mahbob** currently serves as a member of the board at the Institute of Strategic and International Studies (ISIS). Previously he was the Chairman of Telekom Malaysia, Minority Shareholders Watchdog Group, Malaysian Institute of Economic Research, and Jambatan Kedua Sdn. Bhd. He was a former civil servant and has served the Malaysian Government for over 40 years. During his civil service career, he served various ministries and departments, including the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs, and the National Economic Action Council. His last position was Director General of the Economic Planning Unit of the Prime Minister's Department. He has also served at the Institute of Integrity Malaysia, as its first founding President and he was previously the Chairman of Malaysian Investment Development Authority. He had also served on the boards of Petronas, Companies Commission of Malaysia, Malaysia Insurance Deposit Corporation and MCMC. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr Sulaiman is trained in economics, first at the University of Malaya, and then at the University of London. He completed his PhD study at the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at Syracuse University in the USA in early 1986.



**Dr Nizam Mydin Bacha Mydin** is presently the Secretary of The House of Representatives, Parliament of Malaysia. He was formerly the Deputy Undersecretary, Constitution and Parliament, Cabinet, Constitution, and Government Relations Division at the Prime Minister's Department. A PhD holder in Law from the University of Malaya, Master of Law (Monash), and LLB (Malaya). He is an Advocate and Solicitor, and Syariah Practitioner.



**Puan Rahimah Yeop** is presently the Director, Learning & Development at Jendela Ilmu Solutions. Before this, she was a Senior Programme Coordinator at the Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations (IDFR), Malaysia, coordinating the Economic and Public Diplomacy Programme at IDFR. She conducts workshops and lectures areas such as negotiations, cultural communication, and media skills. Apart from IDFR, she had served in the Prime Minister's Department, Consulate of Malaysia in Sydney Australia; and INTAN.
