## About the Speakers/Facilitators/Mentors

### **Tan Sri Datuk Wira Dr. Hj. Mohd Shukor Hj. Mahfar**

Tan Sri Datuk Wira Dr. Hj. Mohd Shukor Bin Hj. Mahfar started his career as a Bank Officer back in 1978; a year later – he took a leap to work with the IRB as an Assessment Officer – a post he knew would one day would rank him as the Director General. Shukor then quickly rose through the ranks in IRB, being appointed Deputy CEO of Compliance, Deputy CEO of Operations, and CEO in January 2011. Throughout the years, he received many accolades and awards - he was elected President of the Malaysian Association of Statutory Bodies and Chairman of The Commonwealth Association of Tax Administrators (CATA); and was awarded the CEO of The Year 2015 by The European Emerging Markets Awards and received the 2015 Lifetime Achievement Award – Outstanding Contribution in Shaping People by The Asia HRD Award. He holds a Bachelor of Economics with University Malaya, a Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science with Malaysia University of Technology, and Master of Taxation and Doctor of Public Administration at the Golden Gate University, USA. He also received an Honorary Doctor of Management from UNITEN and Asia Metropolitan University; appointed the Adjunct Professor of Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM), Universiti Tenaga Nasional (UNITEN), Universiti Tun Abdul Razak (UNITAR), Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM), Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) and University College of Technology Sarawak (UCTS).



### **Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar**

Tan Sri Abdul Wahid Omar, 56, was appointed as a Chairman of Bursa Malaysia on 1 May 2020 and Chairman of the Board of Directors of Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) on 1 November 2018. He is regarded as one of the most versatile corporate leaders in Malaysia having successfully led four major organisations in infrastructure development, telecommunications, financial services and investment management. He served as Group Chairman of Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB), Malaysia's largest fund management company, from August 2016 to June 2018 following completion of his term as a Senator and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department in charge of Economic Planning from June 2013 to June 2016. Tan Sri Abdul Wahid has received numerous awards throughout his career. This includes Malaysia's CEO of the Year 2006 award from Business Times/American Express, The Asian Banker's 2013 Leadership Achievement Award for Malaysia and The Edge Value Creator award 2013. He was also awarded the Honorary Doctorate in Economy from Multimedia University, Malaysia (MMU) in 2014 and Honorary Doctorate in Economy & Muamalat Administration by the Islamic Science University of Malaysia (USIM) in 2018. He was conferred with Panglima Setia Mahkota (PSM) award in 2016 by His Majesty Seri Paduka Baginda Yang DiPertuan Agong for his invaluable contributions to the Country.



### **Dato' Seri Dr. Chen Chaw Min**

Dato' Seri Dr. Chen Chaw Min received his Bachelor in Surveying (Second Upper) from University of Technology, Malaysia in 1985 and Masters in Business Administration (Finance) from University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, USA in 1997. He subsequently went on to obtain his PhD in Finance from University Putra Malaysia in 2005. Dr. Chen started his career with the Malaysian Civil Service in 1988 and has held many posts in the government. His first posting was in Ministry of Rural Development and from 1990 onwards; he has served in various divisions in the Ministry of Finance such as the Budget Division, Investment Division, Housing Loan Division, Finance Division and Fiscal and Economy Division of the Ministry. On 25th April 2014 he joined Ministry of Health as Deputy Secretary General (Finance). On 4th July 2015, Dr. Chen was appointed as the Secretary General (Grade: Staff III) of Ministry of Health Malaysia. Dr. Chen is currently the Chairman of ProtectHealth Malaysia and also a board member of National Heart Institute (IJN), National Kenaf & Tobacco, Clinical Research Malaysia (CRM) and ProtectHealth Corporation. He has published in international and local journals, presented papers in international conferences and published a book in 2010.

Dato' Dr. Zaininah Mohd Zain is a highly respected professional Public Health Consultant.
