Dr. Geoff Mulgan addresses four key areas Malaysia's government can leverage to achieve nation's transformation goals which are organizing innovation within government and public services, changing civil service culture and skills to be fit for the future, strategic planning, implementation and policy making, and new types of measurement in government.

About the Speaker

Geoff Mulgan is CEO of the UK's National Endowment for Science, Technology and the Arts (NESTA). He has held positions as director of the UK Prime Minister's Strategy Unit and director of policy to Tony Blair, founder and director of Demos (praised by the Economist as the UK's most influential think-tank), adviser to the governments of Australia, Canada, USA, Singapore, China, and the European Commission and to the establishment of strategy teams in Australia, France, and Japan, and lecturer at UK, Canadian, and Australian national schools of government as well as universities such as Harvard, Melbourne, LSE, and Oxford. Some of the recent titles he has published include *The Art of Public Strategy: Mobilising Power and Knowledge for the Public Good* and *Good and Bad Power: the Ideals and Betrayals of Government*. With his solid foundation in academia and extensive experience in government the world over, he will address four key areas Malaysia's government can leverage to achieve the nation's transformation goals.

Objectives

To produce large impact – the audience will be encouraged to implement Dr. Mulgan’s ideas on a macro-level as they see fit, to foresee, discuss, and disseminate them inside and outside the civil service.
