About the KSU Vision:

Datuk Loo Took Gee shared her vision for the Ministry of Energy, Green Technology and Water (KeTTHA) with the audience. She covered issues pertaining to the vision she has for KeTTHA and also the challenges faced by public managers. In order to succeed as a leader, she stressed on the importance of hard work, reading, preparing work in advance and having a clear 10 to 20 years vision ahead.

About the Speaker:

Datuk Loo Took Gee was officially appointed as the Secretary General of Ministry of Energy, Green Technology and Water on 1 August 2010. She has 32 years of experience in the civil service. As the Secretary General of KeTTHA, she is very much involved in planning and formulation of strategies and policies for the energy, green technology and water sectors in Malaysia. This includes her contribution of determining fuel price and electricity tariffs based on the market mechanism as well the reform of the electricity market in the country.

Datuk Loo Took Gee was also involved in the formulation of the National Renewable Energy Policy and Action Plan 2009 and the Renewable Energy Act 2011 to enhance the role of renewable energy (RE) towards energy security in the country. She also contributed to the International Energy Agency (IEA) publication of the World Energy Outlook 2009, specifically on the chapter on Malaysia. She was also entrusted to lead in drawing up the National Green Technology Policy of the country. Currently, she is actively involved in the reform of the sewerage industry as a step towards a more sustainable water services industry.

Datuk Loo Took Gee graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree (Hons.) from the University of Malaya in 1978. She obtained her Diploma in Public Administration from the National

Institute of Public Administration in 1979. She completed her Master Degree in Policy Science in Saitama University, Japan in 1990.

Currently she is a board member of the Sustainable Energy Development Malaysia (SEDA) and the Energy Commission (ST). She is also a member of the Policy, Legal and Regulatory Steering Group of the Global CCS Institute.

Objectives:

The objective of the KSU Vision is to allow KSUs to share their vision for their ministries and steps in achieving it. The session also provides a platform for exchange of experience, sharing of knowledge and contestation of ideas between KSU and the audience.

Programme Summary:

Datuk Loo Too Gee's visions for her ministry are as follows:

1. Electricity industry: To transform it to a rules-based industry by strengthening the legal and regulatory environment of the industry. It will be an efficient and competitive industry, with a high level of governance and KeTTHA plan to achieve it by 2020.
2. Water industry: To transform it to be a sustainable industry and to transform the water industry into a rules-based industry, with the National Water Services Commission (SPAN), as the enforcer, or more precisely, the Regulator.
3. Green technology industry: To concentrate on green initiatives which can create value to enable green tech to be the next engine of growth for Malaysia, reminiscent of the ICT industry in the late 90's.

She believed that apart from the Minister, who is the main driver, the KSUs, have to be able to be good navigators to assist the Ministers in driving these visions. Efficiency, transparency, innovation, and a higher level of governance are the essential requirements in the public sector, or more specifically for public managers to improve their service delivery.
