About the KSU Vision Session:

The session was a platform for YBhg. Dato' Long See Wool to share his knowledge and experience on his role as a Secretary General to the Ministry of Transport. Ybhg. Dato' Long's session focused mainly on the issues and challenges faced by the aviation industry in Malaysia.

About the Speaker:

Dato' Long See Wool is the Secretary General of Ministry of Transport (MOT). He helms the planning and implementation of policies with regards to aviation, maritime and land transport. He was also involved in the Government Transformation Programme (GTP) under the Urban Public Transport initiative which is one of the National Key Results Area (NKRA) to ensure urban public transport is enhanced in the Klang Valley through various programmes.

Dato' Long See Wool has more than 32 years of experiences in the civil service and had served in MOT in various capacities including as Principal Assistant Secretary (Airport

Development) of Aviation Division, Under Secretary (Aviation), Aviation Division, and Deputy Secretary-General (Planning).

Dato' Long See Wool has a Bachelor Degree of Literature from University Malaya and a Diploma in Public Management from National Institute of Public Administration (INTAN). Currently, Dato' Long See Wool is the Chairman of Bintulu Port Authorities (BPA) and sit as board member in Malaysian Airport Holding Berhad (MAHB) and Railway Asset Corporation.

Objectives:

The KSU Vision session allows various Secretary-Generals to share their vision for their respective ministries and steps towards achieving it. The session also provides a platform for exchange of experience, sharing of knowledge and contestation of ideas between the speakers and the audience.

Programme Summary:

Dato' Long See Wool's presentation focused mainly on the issues and challenges faced by the aviation industry in Malaysia. The aviation industry is an important section under the portfolio of the Ministry of Transport. He spoke on the need for the Malaysian aviation industry to revamp in order to become a key player in the global market. He acknowledged that there are a broad range of issues to be addressed such as open skies agreements with other countries, competitiveness and marketability of the national carrier and ensuring the sustainability of KLIA as a world class hub. Dato' Long also spoke about the functions of the Ministry of Transport and the Land Public Transport Commission. He addressed questions regarding current issues such as the MAS-Airasia relations; concerns about the country's transportation services; and the need for effective dialogue between the civil service and the media.
